Key Vocabulary

toy - an object for a child to play with

past - history; time that has already
happened

present - existing or happening
now

factory - a building or group of buildings where toys are often made, usually containing machines **museum** - a building in which interesting objects are stored and exhibited

doll - a small model of a human figure, often a baby, used as a child's toy

teddy bear - a soft toy bear **material** - something a thing is or can be made from

wood - a natural material that comes from a tree or shrub

puppet - a movable model of a person or animal that is usually moved either by strings from above or by a hand inside it

glass - a hard material that can break easily, that is usually transparent

transparent - objects can be seen clearly through; a transparent material

metal - a hard material, that is usually shiny
