Key Vocabulary

atlas – a book of maps or charts

pollution – the presence in the environment of a substance which has harmful or poisonous effects

trade – the action of buying and selling goods and services

climate – the weather conditions in an area in general or over a long period

climate zone - are divisions of the Earth's climates into general climate zones according to average temperatures and average rainfall. The three major climate zones on the Earth are the

polar, temperate, and tropical zones.

biome – a large naturally occurring community of flora and fauna occupying a major habitat, e.g. forest

vegetation – plants considered collectively, especially those found in a particular area or habitat

recycle – convert (waste) into reusable material

air quality – the degree to which the air in a particular place is pollution free

climate change - a change in global or regional climate patterns, in particular a change apparent from the mid to late 20th century onwards and attributed largely to the increased levels of atmospheric carbon dioxide produced by the use of fossil fuels.

fair trade - trade between companies in developed countries and producers in developing countries in which fair prices are paid to the producers
