Key Vocabulary

farm – an area of land and its buildings, used for growing crops and rearing animals

farmer – a person who owns or manages a farm

fish – a limbless cold-blooded vertebrate animal with gills and fins living wholly in water

amphibian – a cold-blooded vertebrate animal. They live the first part of their lives in the water and the last part on the land.

mammal – a warm-blooded vertebrate animal that has hair or fur, females that provide milk for their young, and (typically) give birth to live young.

reptile – a vertebrate animal. They have a dry scaly skin and typically lay soft-shelled eggs on land.

bird – a warm-blooded egg-laying vertebrate animal that has feathers, wings, a beak, and typically by being able to fly.

omnivore – an animal or person that eats both plants and animals.

herbivore – an animal that eats plants.

carnivore – an animal that eats other animals.

urban – in, relating to, or characteristic of a town or city.

rural – in, relating to, or characteristic of the countryside
