WALKING TO NURSERY:

Walking with their adult encourages communication, interaction and eye contact, which contributes to brain development and will assist your child with developing their speech and language skills.

RHYME AND SIGN OF THE WEEK:

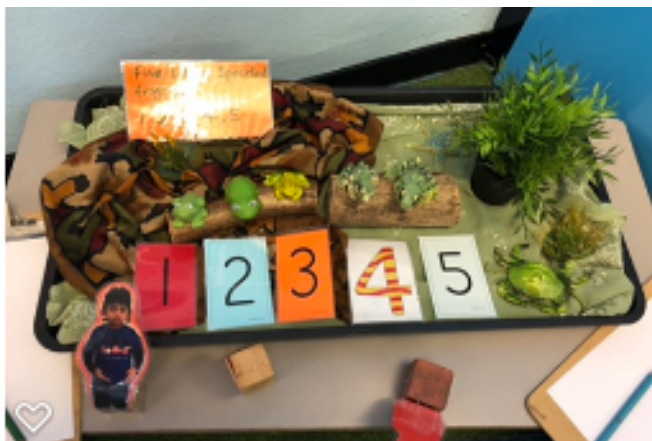
Each week in nursery, we will learn a new nursery rhyme and makaton sign. This helps us build new vocabulary, develop numeracy skills and improve memory and concentration.
